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ABSTRACT

Travelling around the globe for medical treatment is becoming more and more prevalent these days. The fundamental premise of medical tourism is that the same care, or even better quality of care, may be available in other countries, and obtained at a more affordable cost than in the home country (Medical Tourism Association, 2008).
